- We are a physician-led 501-c-3 non-profit established in 2017 dedicated to the public
- We bring FREE CPR and AED education to underserved communities using a grant-funded AED access educational model
- We support one major event each year, the 1st Saturday of June, as our National CPR and AED Education Day

## What We Offer

## AED Access Program

- A group is eligible to receive a donated AED if the following parameters are met
- Learner community aligns with our mission statement
- Learner groups must have 35+ individuals in attendance
- Learners must sign up online in advance of the training
